4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 51.252, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (e), (f), and (g) to read as follows:
7	(e) The department may contract with a qualified individual
8	to assist with the complaint review process.
9	(f) Except for any action by a qualified individual
10	involving fraud, conspiracy, or malice, a qualified individual with
11	whom the department contracts to provide complaint review services
12	is immune from liability and may not be subject to a suit for
13	damages for any act arising from the performance of their duties in:
14	(1) participating in an informal conference to
15	determine the facts of a complaint;
16	(2) evaluating evidence in a complaint filed with the
17	department and offering an expert opinion or technical guidance
18	about possible violations;
19	(3) testifying at a hearing regarding a complaint; and
20	(4) making an evaluation, report, or recommendation
21	regarding a complaint.
22	(g) The department may accept, but is not obligated to
23	investigate, a complaint that lacks sufficient information to
24	identify the source or the name of the person who filed the

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1 complaint.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
