5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 455.053, Occupations Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	Sec. 455.053. RULES REGARDING MASSAGE SCHOOLS. (a) Rules
9	adopted under this chapter relating to a massage school must
10	contain minimum standards for:
11	(1) the issuance, denial, renewal, suspension,
12	revocation, or probation of a license under this chapter;
13	(2) the qualifications of professional personnel;
14	(3) the supervision of professional personnel;

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- (4) the equipment essential to the education, health, 15
- and safety of students, massage school personnel, and the public; 16
- 17 (5) the sanitary and hygienic conditions of a massage
- school; 18
- 19 the provision of massage therapy or other massage
- services by a massage school or student; 20
- the maximum number of hours a student may 21 (7)
- 22 accumulate in a massage school's internship program before the
- student is required to be licensed under this chapter; 23
- 24 (8) the educational and clinical records kept by a

- 1 massage school;
- 2 (9) the organizational structure of a massage school,
- 3 including the lines of authority and the delegation of
- 4 responsibility;
- 5 (10) fire prevention and safety in a massage school;
- 6 (11) the massage school's curriculum and educational
- 7 material;
- 8 (12) massage school inspections; and
- 9 (13) any other aspect of the operation of a massage
- 10 school that the commission considers necessary to protect students,
- 11 massage school personnel, or the public.
- 12 <u>(b) The commission may adopt rules to:</u>
- (1) authorize a massage school to account for any
- 14 hours of instruction completed under this chapter on the basis of
- 15 clock hours or course hours; and
- 16 (2) establish standards for determining the
- 17 equivalency and conversion of clock hours to course hours and
- 18 course hours to clock hours.
- 19 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 455.151, Occupations
- 20 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 455.151. LICENSE OR PERMIT REQUIRED.
- SECTION 3. Sections 455.151(b) and (c), Occupations Code,
- 23 are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (b) Unless the person is exempt from the licensing
- 25 requirement, a person may not represent that the person is a massage
- 26 therapist, massage school, massage therapy instructor, or massage
- 27 establishment unless the person holds an appropriate license under

- 1 this chapter. A person may not represent that the person is a
- 2 massage student or massage intern unless the person holds a student
- 3 permit issued under Section 455.1581.
- 4 (c) A person may not for compensation perform or offer to
- 5 perform any service with a purported health benefit that involves
- 6 physical contact with a client unless the person:
- 7 (1) holds an appropriate license or student permit
- 8 issued under this chapter; or
- 9 (2) is licensed or authorized under other law to
- 10 perform the service.
- 11 SECTION 4. Subchapter D, Chapter 455, Occupations Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 455.1581 to read as follows:
- Sec. 455.1581. STUDENT PERMIT. (a) The department shall
- 14 require a student to hold a student permit if the student:
- 15 (1) is enrolled in a massage school in this state; or
- 16 (2) participates in a student internship program under
- 17 Section 455.159.
- 18 (b) The department shall issue a student permit to an
- 19 applicant who:
- 20 (1) submits an application to the department for a
- 21 student permit in the form prescribed by the executive director;
- 22 (2) satisfies other requirements specified by the
- 23 <u>department; and</u>
- 24 (3) submits with the application a nonrefundable
- 25 application fee in an amount set by the commission.
- 26 (c) The permit must:
- 27 (1) state the student's name; and

- 1 (2) state the name of the school in which the student
- 2 is enrolled or the name of the school or massage therapy instructor
- 3 who supervises and directs the student in a student internship
- 4 program under Section 455.159, as applicable.
- 5 (d) A student permit expires on the first anniversary of the
- 6 dat<u>e of issuance.</u>
- 7 <u>(e) A student permit holder may renew the permit by</u>
- 8 submitting to the department a renewal application on a form
- 9 prescribed by the executive director. The department may not
- 10 charge a fee to renew a permit under this subsection.
- (f) A student permit holder who provides massage therapy as
- 12 part of an internship program or without compensation is exempt
- 13 from licensing under this chapter.
- SECTION 5. Subchapter E, Chapter 455, Occupations Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Sections 455.2031 and 455.2032 to read as
- 16 follows:
- 17 Sec. 455.2031. DAILY ATTENDANCE REPORTS. (a) A massage
- 18 school shall maintain an attendance book showing a record of the
- 19 students' daily attendance.
- 20 (b) The department may inspect a school's attendance record
- 21 book at any time.
- Sec. 455.2032. REPORTS TO DEPARTMENT. (a) A massage school
- 23 <u>shall maintain a monthly progress repo</u>rt regarding each student
- 24 attending the school. The report must certify the daily attendance
- 25 record of each student and the number of course hours and internship
- 26 hours earned by each student during the previous month.
- 27 (b) On a student's completion of a prescribed course of

- 1 instruction, a massage school shall notify the department that the
- 2 student has completed the required number of hours and is eligible
- 3 to take the appropriate examination.
- 4 (c) A massage school shall furnish to the department:
- 5 (1) the current course completion rates of students
- 6 who attend a course of instruction offered by the school; and
- 7 (2) job placement rates and employment rates of
- 8 students who complete the school's course of instruction.
- 9 SECTION 6. The heading to Section 455.204, Occupations
- 10 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 455.204. DISPLAY OF LICENSE OR PERMIT.
- SECTION 7. Sections 455.204(a) and (c), Occupations Code,
- 13 are amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) A person who holds a license or student permit shall
- 15 publicly display the license or permit, as applicable, as specified
- 16 by the department.
- 17 (c) Each massage school, massage student or intern, massage
- 18 establishment, massage therapy instructor, or massage therapist
- 19 shall present the person's license or student permit, as
- 20 <u>applicable</u>, on the request of the department, an authorized
- 21 representative of the department, or a peace officer.
- 22 SECTION 8. Section 455.158, Occupations Code, is repealed.
- 23 SECTION 9. (a) A massage school shall submit the first
- 24 monthly report and the first notice of student completion and
- 25 eligibility required under Section 455.2032, Occupations Code, as
- 26 added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2020.
- 27 (b) Not later than December 1, 2019, the Texas Commission of

- 1 Licensing and Regulation, the Texas Department of Licensing and
- 2 Regulation, and the executive director of the Texas Department of
- 3 Licensing and Regulation, as appropriate, shall adopt any rules or
- 4 forms necessary to implement the changes in law made by this Act to
- 5 Chapter 455, Occupations Code.
- 6 (c) Not later than December 1, 2019, the Texas Department of
- 7 Licensing and Regulation shall begin accepting applications for and
- 8 issuing student permits under Section 455.1581, Occupations Code,
- 9 as added by this Act.
- 10 (d) Notwithstanding Section 455.151, Occupations Code, as
- 11 amended by this Act, Section 455.1581, Occupations Code, as added
- 12 by this Act, Section 455.204, Occupations Code, as amended by this
- 13 Act, and the repeal by this Act of Section 455.158, Occupations
- 14 Code, a student enrolled in a massage school in this state or
- 15 participating in a student internship program under Section
- 16 455.159, Occupations Code, is not required to comply with the
- 17 changes in law made by this Act until June 1, 2020.
- 18 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
