- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1701.3101 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1701.3101. JAILER AT PRIVATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
- 8 (a) This section applies only to a person serving as a jailer in a
- 9 correctional facility operated by a private vendor.
- 10 (b) The commission by rule shall require a jailer to whom
- 11 this section applies to complete the preparatory training program
- 12 described by Section 1701.310 not later than the 180th day after the
- 13 date the jailer is hired. A jailer who does not complete the
- 14 program as required by this subsection shall be removed from the
- 15 position and may not serve as a jailer in any facility until
- 16 completing the program.
- (c) A jailer may not serve in a supervisory position unless
- 18 the person has satisfactorily completed the preparatory training
- 19 program.
- 20 <u>(d) A jailer who has not satisfactorily completed the</u>
- 21 preparatory training program must be under the direct supervision
- 22 of a jailer who has satisfactorily completed the preparatory
- 23 training program.
- (e) At any time, the number of jailers employed at a

- 1 <u>facility operated by a private vendor who have not satisfactorily</u>
- 2 completed the training program may not exceed 10 percent of the
- 3 total number of jailers employed at that facility.
