- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.0256(a), Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A recipient described by Section 32.025(a) who
- 8 experiences a temporary increase in income of a duration of one
- 9 month or less, or who commits a minor technical or clerical error on
- 10 <u>a renewal application or other document required for benefits</u>
- 11 renewal, that would normally result in the recipient being
- 12 ineligible for medical assistance continues to be eligible for that
- 13 assistance if the individual:
- 14 (1) either:
- 15 (A) receives services through a program for
- 16 individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability
- 17 authorized under Section 1915(c), Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- 18 Section 1396n(c)); or
- 19 (B) resides in an ICF-IID facility; and
- 20 (2) continues to meet the functional and diagnostic
- 21 criteria for the receipt of services under a program described by
- 22 Subdivision (1)(A) or for residency in an ICF-IID facility.
- 23 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 24 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

- 1 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 2 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 3 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 4 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
