A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to driver's licenses, commercial driver's licenses, and 3 other identification certificates; authorizing and increasing 4 fees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Sections 521.009(a), (a-1), and (c),
Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

8 (a) The department may establish a program for the provision 9 of renewal and duplicate driver's license, election identification 10 certificate, and personal identification certificate services <u>by</u> 11 [in] counties, [and] municipalities, and private vendors that enter 12 into an agreement with the department under Subsection (a-1).

(a-1) Under the program, the department may enter into an 13 14 agreement with the commissioners court of a county, [or] the governing body of a municipality, or a private vendor to permit 15 16 county, [or] municipal, or vendor employees to provide services at a county or municipal office or at a location determined by the 17 vendor relating to the issuance of renewal and duplicate driver's 18 licenses, election identification certificates, and personal 19 20 identification certificates, including:

(1) taking photographs;

22 (2) administering vision tests;

(3) updating a driver's license, election
identification certificate, or personal identification certificate

1 to change a name, address, or photograph;

2 (4) distributing and collecting information relating
3 to donations under Section 521.401;

4

(5) collecting fees; and

5 (6) performing other basic ministerial functions and 6 tasks necessary to issue renewal and duplicate driver's licenses, 7 election identification certificates, and personal identification 8 certificates.

9 (c) A participating county, [or] municipality, or private 10 <u>vendor</u> must remit to the department for deposit as required by this 11 chapter fees collected for the issuance of a renewal or duplicate 12 driver's license or personal identification certificate.

SECTION 2. Section 521.165(c), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

15 (c) <u>In</u> [Except as provided by Subsection (d), in] issuing a 16 driver's license for certain types of vehicles, the director may 17 waive a driving test for an applicant who has successfully 18 completed and passed the training and testing conducted by a person 19 certified under Subsection (a).

20 SECTION 3. Section 521.271(a), Transportation Code, is 21 amended to read as follows:

(a) Each original driver's license, provisional license,
learner license, or occupational driver's license issued to an
applicant who is a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident
of the United States or a refugee or asylee lawfully admitted into
the United States expires as follows:

(1) except as provided by Section 521.2711, a driver's

license expires on the eighth [first birthday of the license holder 1 occurring after the sixth] anniversary of the date of the 2 3 application; a provisional license expires on the 18th birthday 4 (2) 5 of the license holder; 6 (3) a learner license expires on the 18th birthday of 7 the license holder; 8 (4) an occupational driver's license expires on the first anniversary of the court order granting the license; and 9 10 (5) unless an earlier date is otherwise provided, a driver's license issued to a person whose residence or domicile is a 11 12 correctional facility or a parole facility expires on the first birthday of the license holder occurring after the first 13 14 anniversary of the date of issuance. 15 SECTION 4. Section 521.421(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 16 17 (a) The fee for issuance or renewal of a license not otherwise provided for by this section is $32 [\frac{24}{24}]$. 18 19 SECTION 5. Section 521.428, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 20 21 Sec. 521.428. COUNTY, [OR] MUNICIPAL, OR PRIVATE VENDOR FEE. (a) A county or municipality that provides services under an 22 23 agreement described by Section 521.009 may collect an additional 24 fee of up to \$5 for each transaction provided that relates to driver's license and personal identification certificate services 25 26 only. (b) A private vendor that provides services under an 27

2	fee of up to \$10 for each transaction described by Subsection (a).
3	SECTION 6. Section 522.029, Transportation Code, is amended
4	by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (m) to read as
5	follows:
6	(a) The fee for a commercial driver's license issued by the
7	department is <u>$\\$96$</u> [$\60], except as provided by Subsections (f),
8	(h), (j), [and] (k) <u>, and (m)</u> .
9	(m) The fee for a commercial driver's license with a
10	hazardous materials endorsement issued by the department is \$60,
11	except as provided by Subsections (h), (j), and (k).
12	SECTION 7. Section 522.051, Transportation Code, is amended
13	by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), (d), and (f) and adding
14	Subsections (i), (j), (k), and (l) to read as follows:
15	(a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsection] (f) <u>and</u>
16	(i) and Sections 522.013(e), 522.033, and 522.054, an original
17	commercial driver's license expires <u>eight</u> [five] years after the
18	applicant's next birthday.
19	(b) Except as provided by <u>Subsection (j) and</u> Section
20	522.054, a commercial driver's license issued to a person holding a
21	Texas Class A, B, C, or M license that would expire one year or more
22	after the date of issuance of the commercial driver's license
23	expires <u>eight</u> [five] years after the applicant's next birthday.
24	(c) Except as provided by <u>Subsection (k) and</u> Section
25	522.054, a commercial driver's license issued to a person holding a
26	Texas Class A, B, C, or M license that would expire less than one
27	year after the date of issuance of the commercial driver's license

or that has been expired for less than one year expires <u>eight</u> [five]
 years after the expiration date shown on the Class A, B, C, or M
 license.

(d) Except as provided by <u>Subsection (1) and</u> Section
522.054, a commercial driver's license issued to a person holding a
Texas Class A, B, C, or M license that has been expired for at least
one year but not more than two years expires <u>eight</u> [five] years
after the applicant's last birthday.

9 (f) Except as provided by Section 522.013, a non-domiciled 10 commercial driver's license other than a temporary non-domiciled 11 commercial driver's license under Section 522.013(e) expires on:

12

(1) the earlier of:

(A) the first birthday of the license holder
occurring after the <u>eighth</u> [fifth] anniversary of the date of the
application; or

16 (B) the expiration date of the license holder's 17 lawful presence in the United States as determined by the 18 appropriate United States agency in compliance with federal law; or

19 (2) the first anniversary of the date of issuance, if 20 there is no definitive expiration date for the applicant's 21 authorized stay in the United States.

(i) Except as provided by Subsection (f) and Sections 522.013(e), 522.033, and 522.054, an original commercial driver's license with a hazardous materials endorsement expires five years after the applicant's next birthday.

26 (j) Except as provided by Section 522.054, a commercial 27 driver's license with a hazardous materials endorsement issued to a

person holding a Texas Class A, B, C, or M license that would expire 1 one year or more after the date of issuance of the commercial 2 driver's license expires five years after the applicant's next 3 4 birthday. 5 (k) Except as provided by Section 522.054, a commercial driver's license with a hazardous materials endorsement issued to a 6 person holding a Texas Class A, B, C, or M license that would expire 7 less than one year after the date of issuance of the commercial 8 driver's license or that has been expired for less than one year 9 10 expires five years after the expiration date shown on the Class A, B, C, or M license. 11 12 (1) Except as provided by Section 522.054, a commercial driver's license with a hazardous materials endorsement issued to a 13 person holding a Texas Class A, B, C, or M license that has been 14

15 <u>expired for at least one year but not more than two years expires</u> 16 <u>five years after the applicant's last birthday.</u> 17 SECTION 8. Section 522.052, Transportation Code, is amended

18 by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsections (k) and 19 (l) to read as follows:

(b) Except as provided by Section 522.054, a renewal of a commercial driver's license that has been expired for less than one year expires <u>eight</u> [five] years after the expiration date shown on the commercial driver's license.

(c) Except as provided by Section 522.054, a renewal of a
commercial driver's license that has been expired for at least one
year but not more than two years expires <u>seven</u> [six] years after the
applicant's last birthday.

(k) Except as provided by Section 522.054, a renewal of a 1 commercial driver's license with a hazardous materials endorsement 2 that has been expired for less than one year expires five years 3 after the expiration date shown on the commercial driver's license. 4 (1) Except as provided by Section 522.054, a renewal of a 5 6 commercial driver's license with a hazardous materials endorsement 7 that has been expired for at least one year but not more than two 8 years expires five years after the applicant's last birthday.

9 SECTION 9. Section 521.165(d), Transportation Code, is 10 repealed.

SECTION 10. The changes in law made by this Act to Sections 11 521.271, 521.421, 522.029, 522.051, and 522.052, Transportation 12 Code, apply only to a driver's license or commercial driver's 13 license issued or renewed on or after June 1, 2020. A driver's 14 15 license or commercial driver's license issued or renewed before June 1, 2020, is governed by the law in effect immediately before 16 17 the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 18

19 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
