1-18 relating to the administration of a veterans treatment court
1-19 program.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 124.003(b), Government Code, is amended
1-22 to read as follows:

1-23 (b) A veterans treatment court program established under
1-24 this chapter shall make, establish, and publish local procedures to
1-25 ensure maximum participation of eligible defendants in the program
1-26 [~~county or counties in which those defendants reside~~].

1-27 SECTION 2. Sections 124.006(a) and (d), Government Code,
1-28 are amended to read as follows:

1-29 (a) A veterans treatment court program that accepts
1-30 placement of a defendant may transfer responsibility for
1-31 supervising the defendant's participation in the program to another
1-32 veterans treatment court program that is located in the county
1-33 where the defendant works or resides or in a county adjacent to the
1-34 county where the defendant works or resides. The defendant's
1-35 supervision may be transferred under this section only with the
1-36 consent of both veterans treatment court programs and the
1-37 defendant.

1-38 (d) If a defendant is charged with an offense in a county
1-39 that does not operate a veterans treatment court program, the court
1-40 in which the criminal case is pending may place the defendant in a
1-41 veterans treatment court program located in the county where the
1-42 defendant works or resides or in a county adjacent to the county
1-43 where the defendant works or resides, provided that a program is
1-44 operated in that county and the defendant agrees to the placement.
1-45 A defendant placed in a veterans treatment court program in
1-46 accordance with this subsection must agree to abide by all rules,
1-47 requirements, and instructions of the program.

1-48 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-49 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-50 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-51 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-52 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
