17	(A) compliance with traffic safety or motor
18	carrier safety laws;
19	(B) safety of a motor vehicle;
20	(C) safety of an operator of a motor vehicle; and
21	(D) safety of third-party users of public

1	person's commercial motor vehicle by or at the request of a motor
2	carrier, including through contract with a motor carrier, may not
3	be considered when determining whether the person is an employee of
4	the motor carrier or an independent contractor for purposes of
5	state law.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
