- 10 MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT RESULTING IN DEATH OF PERSON. (a) A judge
- 11 granting community supervision to a defendant convicted of an
- offense punishable under Section 550.021(c)(1)(A), Transportation
- 13 Code, shall require as a condition of community supervision that
- 14 the defendant submit to a term of confinement of not less than 120
- 15 days.
- 16 (b) If a sentence of confinement is imposed on the
- 17 revocation of community supervision, the term of confinement served
- 18 under Subsection (a) may not be credited toward completion of the
- 19 <u>sentence imposed.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 23 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 24 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For

- 1 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 2 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 3 before that date.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
