BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 42A, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended by adding Article 42A.515 to read as follows: 8 9 Art. 42A.515. COMMUNITY SUPERVISION FOR LEAVING SCENE OF MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT RESULTING IN DEATH OF PERSON. (a) A judge 10 granting community supervision to a defendant convicted of an 11 offense punishable under Section 550.021(c)(1)(A), Transportation 12 Code, shall require as a condition of community supervision that 13 14 the defendant submit to a term of confinement of not less than 120 days. 15 16 (b) If a sentence of confinement is imposed on the revocation of community supervision, the term of confinement served 17 under Subsection (a) may not be credited toward completion of the 18 sentence imposed. 19 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 21 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 22 23 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 24 For

1 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 2 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 3 before that date.
