## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to workers' compensation death benefit eligibility for

- 3 certain spouses of first responders killed in the line of duty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 408.183(b-1), Labor Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), an eligible spouse
- 8 who remarried is eligible for death benefits for life if the
- 9 employee was a first responder, as defined by Section 504.055, or an
- 10 individual described by Section 615.003(1), Government Code, who
- 11 suffered death in the course and scope of employment or while
- 12 providing services as a volunteer. This subsection applies
- 13 regardless of the date on which the death of the first responder or
- 14 other individual occurred.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 16 408.183(b-1), Labor Code, applies only to an eligible spouse who
- 17 remarries on or after the effective date of this Act. An eligible
- 18 spouse who remarried before that date is governed by the law as it
- 19 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 20 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
