- 5 (e) The minimum number of signatures that must appear on the

- 7 Section 172.025 to appear on a petition of a candidate for
- 8 <u>nomination for the same office in a general primary election.</u>
- 9 (f) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 10 implement this section.
