- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 551.128(a) and (b-1), Government Code,

- 11 (2) "Water district" has the meaning assigned by

- 13 (b-1) A transit authority or department subject to Chapter
- 14 451, 452, 453, or 460, Transportation Code, an elected school
- 15 district board of trustees for a school district that has a student
- 16 enrollment of 10,000 or more, an elected governing body of a
- 17 home-rule municipality that has a population of 50,000 or more, \underline{a}
- 18 water district that serves a population of 50,000 or more, or a
- 19 county commissioners court for a county that has a population of
- 20 125,000 or more shall:
- 21 (1) make a video and audio recording of reasonable
- 22 quality of each:
- 23 (A) regularly scheduled open meeting that is not

- 1 (B) open meeting that is a work session or
- 2 special called meeting if:
- 3 (i) the governmental body is an elected

- 7 meeting, the board of trustees votes on any matter or allows public
- 8 comment or testimony; and
- 9 (2) make available an archived copy of the video and
- 10 audio recording of each meeting described by Subdivision (1) on the
- 11 Internet.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
