10	costs, if the claim is for:
11	(1) rendered services;
12	(2) performed labor;
13	<pre>(3) furnished material;</pre>
14	(4) freight or express overcharges;
15	(5) lost or damaged freight or express;
16	(6) killed or injured stock;
17	(7) a sworn account; or
18	(8) an oral or written contract.
19	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
20	to an award of attorney's fees in an action commenced on or after
21	the effective date of this Act. An award of attorney's fees in an
22	action commenced before the effective date of this Act is governed
23	by the law applicable to the award immediately before the effective
