Section 2306.0721(c), Government 4 Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 (c) The plan must include: (1) an estimate and analysis of the size and the 7 different housing needs of the following populations in each 8 uniform state service region: 9 individuals and families of moderate, low, (A) 10 11 very low, and extremely low income; 12 (B) individuals with special needs; 13 (C) homeless individuals; 14 (D) veterans; (E) farmworkers; 15 youth who are aging out of foster care; [and] 16 (F) homeless youth, as defined by Section 17 (G) 2306.1101, and other individuals older than 18 years of age and 18 younger than 25 years of age who are homeless; and 19 (H) elderly individuals; 20 21 (2) a proposal to use all available housing resources 22 to address the housing needs of the populations described by 23 Subdivision (1) by establishing funding levels for all housing-related programs; 24

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1 (3) an estimate of the number of federally assisted 2 housing units available for individuals and families of low and 3 very low income and individuals with special needs in each uniform 4 state service region;

5 (4) a description of state programs that govern the 6 use of all available housing resources;

7 (5) a resource allocation plan that targets all 8 available housing resources to individuals and families of low and 9 very low income and individuals with special needs in each uniform 10 state service region;

11 (6) a description of the department's efforts to 12 monitor and analyze the unused or underused federal resources of 13 other state agencies for housing-related services and services for 14 homeless individuals and the department's recommendations to 15 ensure the full use by the state of all available federal resources 16 for those services in each uniform state service region;

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1 development organizations, and community action agencies; (11)strategies for meeting rural housing needs; 2 3 (12)a biennial action plan for colonias that: addresses current policy goals for colonia 4 (A) programs, strategies to meet the policy goals, and the projected 5 outcomes with respect to the policy goals; and 6 7 (B) includes information on the demand for 8 contract-for-deed conversions, services from self-help centers, consumer education, and other colonia resident services in counties 9 10 some part of which is within 150 miles of the international border of this state; 11 12 (13)a summary of public comments received at а hearing under this chapter or from another source that concern the 13 14 demand for colonia resident services described by Subdivision (12); 15 and (13-a) information regarding 16 foreclosures of 17 residential property in this state, including the number and geographic location of those foreclosures. 18 19 SECTION 2. Section 2306.905(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 20 21 In accomplishing the council's duties under this (b) section, the [The] council and each of its represented agencies may 22 23 seek program or policy assistance from the Texas Homeless Network 24 or any other organization in this state that has a network of providers with expertise in assisting homeless youth 25 [in accomplishing the council's duties]. 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 27

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
