Subchapter C, Chapter 63, Water Code, is amended by adding Section 63.1045 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 63.1045. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. (a) The district may 7 employ an executive director of the district. If the district 8 9 employs an executive director, the district must prescribe the duties and compensation of the executive director. 10 11 (b) The duties of an executive director may be performed by 12 a general manager, port director, or chief executive officer. 13 SECTION 2. Section 63.105, Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 14 Sec. 63.105. ENGINEER. The district [commission] 15 may employ a competent engineer whose term of office and compensation 16 shall be determined by the <u>district</u> [commission]. 17 18 SECTION 3. Section 63.107, Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 Sec. 63.107. DISTRICT EMPLOYEES. (a) The district: 20 21 (1) [commission] may employ assistant engineers and other persons as it considers necessary for the construction, 22 23 maintenance, operation, and development of the district and $[\tau]$ its business and facilities; $[-\tau]$ and 24

No. 2565 1 (2) shall determine their term of office and duties $[\tau]$ 2 and fix their compensation. 3 (b) All employees may be removed by the district [commission]. 4 5 SECTION 4. Section 63.109, Water Code, is amended to read as 6 follows: Sec. 63.109. PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES. 7 The <u>district</u> [commission] may draw warrants, issue checks, or use a 8 payment method adopted under Section 60.271 to pay for: 9 10 (1) [legal] services; (2) [, for] the compensation [salaries] of [the 11 12 engineer, his assistant, or any other] employees; and (3) [, and for] all expenses incident and relating to 13 14 the district. 15 SECTION 5. The heading to Section 63.175, Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 16 Sec. 63.175. SUPERVISION OF WORK [BY ENGINEER]. 17 SECTION 6. Section 63.175(a), Water Code, is amended to 18 read as follows: 19 (a) Unless done under the supervision of the United States, 20 all work contracted for by the district [commission] shall be done 21 under the supervision of a representative of the district 22 23 [engineer]. 24 SECTION 7. Sections 63.176(a) and (b), Water Code, are 25 amended to read as follows: (a) A representative of the district [The commission] shall 26

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inspect the work being done during its progress, and on completion

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of the contract, the <u>district</u> [commission] shall draw a warrant on the district depository <u>or issue a check</u> in favor of the contractor or <u>the contractor's</u> [his] assignee for the amount of the contract price. The warrant <u>or check</u> shall be paid from the construction and maintenance <u>or operating</u> fund.

6 (b) If the <u>district</u> [commission] considers it advisable, it 7 may contract to pay for the work in partial payments as the work 8 progresses. <u>Partial</u>[, <u>but the partial</u>] payments may not be more in 9 the aggregate than <u>the amount allowed under applicable laws</u> [90 10 percent of the contract price of the total amount of work done under 11 <u>the contract</u>]. The amount of the work shall be shown by a 12 certificate of <u>a representative of</u> the <u>district</u> [<u>engineer</u>].

SECTION 8. Subchapter D, Chapter 63, Water Code, is amended by adding Section 63.184 to read as follows:

15 <u>Sec. 63.184. DISPOSITION OF SALVAGE OR SURPLUS PROPERTY.</u> 16 <u>The commission may authorize the executive director or the</u> 17 <u>executive director's designee to sell, destroy, donate, or</u> 18 <u>otherwise dispose of the district's surplus or salvage personal</u> 19 <u>property by any method the executive director or the executive</u> 20 <u>director's designee determines is in the best interest of the</u> 21 <u>district.</u>

SECTION 9. Section 63.175(b), Water Code, is repealed.
SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
