 1-24 AN ACT

1-25 relating to the award of grants by the Cancer Prevention and
 1-26 Research Institute of Texas Oversight Committee and to the payment
 1-27 of claims related to those grants by the comptroller of public
 1-28 accounts.

1-29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-30 SECTION 1. Section 403.071(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-31 to read as follows:

1-32 (b) A claim may not be paid from an appropriation unless the
 1-33 claim is presented to the comptroller for payment not later than two
 1-34 years after the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation
 1-35 was made. However, a claim may be presented:

1-36 (1) not later than four years after the end of the
 1-37 fiscal year for which the appropriation from which the claim is to
 1-38 be paid was made if the appropriation relates to:

1-39 (A) new construction contracts;

1-40 (B) ~~to~~ grants awarded under Chapter 391,
 1-41 Health and Safety Code;

1-42 (C) ~~or to~~ repair and remodeling projects that
 1-43 exceed the amount of \$20,000, including furniture and other
 1-44 equipment and ~~and~~ architects' and engineering fees; ~~and~~

1-45 (D) other costs related to the contracts or
 1-46 projects; or

1-47 (2) not later than seven years after the end of the
 1-48 fiscal year for which the appropriation from which the claim is to
 1-49 be paid was made if the appropriation relates to grants awarded
 1-50 under Chapter 102, Health and Safety Code.

1-51 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
