6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 531.0095 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 531.0095. EMPLOYEE GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE. The executive
9	commissioner by rule shall establish a grievance procedure for
10	commission employees and employees of the Department of Family and
11	Protective Services. The procedure must allow an employee to
12	appeal a dispute regarding:
13	(1) a disciplinary action, including:
14	(A) an oral or written reprimand;
15	(B) a demotion;
16	(C) a suspension;
17	(D) a reduction in compensation; and
18	(E) a termination for cause and at will; or
19	(2) the employee's compensation or working conditions,
20	including required working hours.
21	SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2020, the executive
22	commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
23	adopt rules necessary to implement Section 531.0095, Government
24	Code, as added by this Act.
