9	regional education service center, in cooperation with the Teacher
10	Retirement System of Texas, shall annually collaborate with school
11	districts in the center's region to:
12	(1) organize an educational workshop to provide
13	information to district employees regarding:
14	(A) health benefits for district employees and
15	retirees, including:
16	(i) benefits provided by each district; and
17	(ii) health benefit plans administered by
18	the Teacher Retirement System of Texas;
19	(B) retirement benefits, including benefits
20	provided by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas; and
21	(C) personal financial literacy regarding health
22	care and retirement planning; and
23	(2) distribute the information described by
24	Subdivision (1) to the district employees.
