## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 45.103, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 (b) A court may order a change of name under this subchapter
- 10 for a person with a final felony conviction if:
- 11 (1)  $[\tau]$  in addition to the requirements of Subsection
- 12 (a), the person has:
- 13  $\underline{\text{(A)}}$  [\(\frac{\((1)\)}{\(1)\)}] received a certificate of discharge by
- 14 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or completed a period of
- 15 community supervision or juvenile probation ordered by a court and
- 16 not less than two years have passed from the date of the receipt of
- 17 discharge or completion of community supervision or juvenile
- 18 probation; or
- 19  $\underline{\text{(B)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$ ] been pardoned; or
- 20 (2) the person is requesting to change the person's
- 21 name to the primary name used in the person's criminal history
- 22 record information.
- (c) A court may order a change of name under this subchapter
- 24 for a person subject to the registration requirements of Chapter

- 1 62, Code of Criminal Procedure, if the person:
- 2 <u>(1) meets</u> [, in addition to] the requirements of
- 3 Subsection (a) or is requesting to change the person's name to the
- 4 primary name used in the person's criminal history record
- 5 information; and
- (2) [ $\tau$  the person] provides the court with proof that
- 7 the person has notified the appropriate local law enforcement
- 8 authority of the proposed name change.
- 9 (d) In this section:
- 10 (1) "Criminal history record information" has the
- 11 meaning assigned by Section 411.082, Government Code.
- 12 (2) "Local [subsection, "local] law enforcement
- 13 authority" has the meaning assigned by Article 62.001, Code of
- 14 Criminal Procedure.
- SECTION 2. Section 45.103, Family Code, as amended by this
- 16 Act, applies only to a petition for a change of name that is filed on
- 17 or after the effective date of this Act. A petition filed before
- 18 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 19 the date the petition was filed, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
