2	relating to the consumption, possession, or sale of an alcoholic
3	beverage at a performing arts facility leased to a nonprofit
4	organization by a school district.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 109.33, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
7	amended by adding Subsection (f-1) to read as follows:
8	(f-1) Subsections (a)(2) and (3) do not apply to a
9	performing arts facility leased to a nonprofit organization under a
10	policy adopted under Section 11.179, Education Code.
11	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
12	amended by adding Section 11.179 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 11.179. SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN CERTAIN LEASED
14	DISTRICT FACILITIES. (a) The board of trustees of a school
15	district may adopt a policy allowing the consumption, possession,
16	and sale of an alcoholic beverage at an event held at a performing
17	arts facility owned by the district if:
18	(1) the facility is leased to a nonprofit organization
19	for an event not sponsored or sanctioned by the district; and
20	(2) the district is located in a county:
21	(A) that has a population of not more than
22	<u>300,000; and</u>
23	(B) in which a component university of the
24	University of Houston System is located.

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1	(b) A lease agreement entered into as provided by Subsection
2	(a) must require that:
3	(1) the event be held outside of regular school hours;
4	and
5	(2) the alcoholic beverages be sold by a person who
6	holds an appropriate retail license or permit under the Alcoholic
7	Beverage Code for the facility.
8	SECTION 3. Section 37.122, Education Code, is amended by
9	adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
10	(a-1) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that
11	the person possessed the intoxicating beverage:
12	(1) at a performing arts facility; and
13	(2) during an event held outside of regular school
14	hours and not sponsored or sanctioned by a school district.
15	SECTION 4. Section 38.007, Education Code, is amended by
16	adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
17	(a-1) This section does not apply to a performing arts
18	facility leased to a nonprofit organization for an event as
19	provided by Section 11.179.
20	SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act to Section
21	37.122, Education Code, applies only to an offense committed on or
22	after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before
23	the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
24	the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued
25	in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an
26	offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any
27	element of the offense was committed before that date.

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1 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
