A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the dissolution of a direct-support organization established by the Prepaid Higher Education Tuition Board and the 1-20 transfer of funds related to prepaid higher education tuition scholarships to the Texas Match the Promise Foundation or a 1-21 1-22 1-23 successor entity.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 54.633, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (n) to read as follows: 1-25 1-26

1-27 1-28 (n) The comptroller may dissolve a direct-support organization established under Subsection (e) if the comptroller determines that the purpose of the organization has been 1-29 substantially complied with and orders the dissolution. On 1-30 1-31 dissolution of the organization, title to all funds and property held by the organization is transferred to the Texas Match the Promise Foundation or a successor entity. SECTION 2.
