## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) In addition to other appropriations made by
- 7 the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, the amount of
- 8 \$2,720,000 is appropriated from the general revenue fund to the
- 9 Health and Human Services Commission for the state fiscal biennium
- 10 ending August 31, 2021, for the purpose of entering into a contract
- 11 with a statewide organization that shall provide training,
- 12 technical assistance, evaluation services, and funds
- 13 administration to support contractual requirements for local
- 14 children's advocacy center programs. The statewide organization
- 15 must be exempt from federal income taxation and be composed of
- 16 individuals or groups of individuals who have expertise in the
- 17 establishment and operation of children's advocacy center
- 18 programs.
- 19 (b) In addition to other appropriations made by the 86th
- 20 Legislature, Regular Session, 2019, the amount of \$2,640,000 is
- 21 appropriated from the general revenue fund to the Health and Human
- 22 Services Commission for the state fiscal biennium ending August 31,
- 23 2021, for the purpose of entering into a contract with a statewide
- 24 organization that shall provide training, technical assistance,

- 1 and evaluation services for the benefit of local volunteer advocate
- 2 programs, including court-appointed special advocate programs.
- 3 The statewide organization must be exempt from federal income
- 4 taxation and be composed of individuals or groups of individuals
- 5 who have expertise in the dynamics of child abuse and neglect and
- 6 experience in operating volunteer advocate programs.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
