Sections 54.5341(b) and (f), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) Unless a higher amount is approved under Subsection (f), the [The] amount of the fee may not exceed: 8 9 (1) \$40 per student for each regular semester; \$30 per student for each summer session of 12 weeks 10 (2) or longer; 11 \$15 per student for each summer session of six 12 (3) weeks or more but less than 12 weeks; and 13 14 (4) \$10 per student for each summer session that is shorter than six weeks. 15 16 (f) The board may not increase the amount of the recreational facility fee unless the amount of the increase is 17 approved by a majority vote of the students participating in a 18 general student election held at the university for that purpose. 19 The ballot proposition for an election under this subsection must 20 clearly state the amount of the proposed fee increase and describe 21 the reason for the proposed fee increase. 22 SECTION 2. Section 54.5341, Education Code, as amended by 23 this Act, applies beginning with fees imposed for the 2019 fall

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
