- (1) the seller or retailer is a nonprofit organization 10

- (3) the purchaser is a person attending 15

- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect 17
- tax liability accruing before the effective date of this Act. That 18
- liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been enacted, 19
- and the former law is continued in effect for the collection of 20
- taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of the liability 21
- 22 for those taxes.
