## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 408.183(b-1), Labor Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), an eligible spouse
- 9 who remarried is eligible for death benefits for life if the
- 10 employee was a first responder, as defined by Section 504.055, or an
- 11 <u>individual described by Section 501.001(5)(F)</u>, who suffered death
- 12 in the course and scope of employment or while providing services as
- 13 a volunteer. This subsection applies regardless of the date on
- 14 which the death of the first responder or other individual
- 15 occurred.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- $17 \quad 408.183(b-1)$ , Labor Code, applies only to an eligible spouse who
- 18 remarries on or after the effective date of this Act. An eligible
- 19 spouse who remarried before that date is governed by the law as it
- 20 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 21 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
