4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 531.09991 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.09991. GRANT PROGRAM FOR COMMUNITY-BASED SUICIDE
8	PREVENTION EFFORTS. (a) To the extent money is available to the
9	commission for that purpose, the commission shall establish a
10	program to provide grants to quasi-governmental or nonprofit
11	entities for the purpose of establishing and enhancing
12	community-based suicide prevention efforts.
13	(b) Grant money awarded under this section may be used only
14	to:
15	(1) support the implementation, administration, and
16	coordination of the 2018 Texas State Plan for Suicide Prevention
17	adopted by the Texas Suicide Prevention Council;
18	(2) support the operations of the quasi-governmental
19	and nonprofit entities receiving grant money to expand local
20	community-based suicide prevention efforts;
21	(3) support suicide prevention efforts in certain
22	communities of practice, including veterans, primary and secondary
23	education students, higher education students, persons who reside
24	in rural areas, and persons working in health care;

1	(4) facilitate statewide partnerships and
2	collaborations;
3	(5) expand the capacities of community-based suicide
4	prevention programs to collect and analyze information to inform
5	suicide prevention strategies;
6	(6) foster and promote emerging and promising best
7	practices in suicide prevention;
8	(7) offer outreach and communications structures
9	supporting the 2018 Texas State Plan for Suicide Prevention; or
10	(8) subcontract with another quasi-governmental or
11	nonprofit entity acceptable to the commission to accomplish the
12	purposes described by Subdivisions (1)-(7).
13	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
14	of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
15	Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
16	Section 531.09991, Government Code, as added by this Act.
17	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
