1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to an anatomical gift on behalf of a resident in a state
1-20 supported living center.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 555, Health and Safety
1-23 Code, is amended by adding Section 555.027 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 555.027. ANATOMICAL GIFT. (a) The executive
1-25 commissioner by rule shall prescribe a form that a resident's
1-26 guardian may sign on behalf of a resident if the resident's guardian
1-27 elects to make an anatomical gift on behalf of the resident in
1-28 accordance with Chapter 692A.

1-29 (b) Subsection (a) does not preclude a guardian from
1-30 executing a document in accordance with Chapter 692A that
1-31 supersedes the form executed under that subsection.

1-32 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2019, the executive
1-33 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
1-34 prescribe the form as required by Section 555.027, Health and
1-35 Safety Code, as added by this Act.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
