8	section, "state agency" means a board, commission, council,

11	includes an institution of higher education as defined by Section
12	61.003, Education Code.
13	(b) Not later than August 1 of each year, each state agency
14	shall conduct a workplace climate survey of agency employees to
15	gather information on the incidence of sexual harassment in the
16	agency's workplace and means of addressing the harassment. The
17	<pre>survey must:</pre>
18	(1) be voluntary for participants;
19	(2) allow participants to maintain anonymity and
20	confidentiality of responses; and
21	(3) be based on scientific research and workplace best

- 1 elements of the agency's workplace climate that may be associated

- 7 SECTION 2. A state agency is not required to comply with
- 8 Section 651.011, Government Code, as added by this Act, until
- 9 August 1, 2020.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
