## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to regulation of the retail sale of fireworks.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2154.001(11), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (11) "Jobber" means a person who purchases fireworks
- 7 [only] for resale to retailers.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 2154.153(a), Occupations Code, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A person must be a licensed jobber if the person stores,
- 11 possesses, and sells Fireworks 1.4G  $[\frac{\text{only}}{\text{only}}]$  to retailers in this
- 12 state.
- SECTION 3. Section 2154.202(a), Occupations Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) Except as authorized under Section 2154.208, a [A]
- 16 person selling fireworks directly to the public must annually
- 17 obtain a nonrenewable retail fireworks permit for each retail
- 18 location.
- 19 SECTION 4. Subchapter E, Chapter 2154, Occupations Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Section 2154.208 to read as follows:
- Sec. 2154.208. SALE OF FIREWORKS TO PUBLIC BY LICENSED
- 22 JOBBERS. (a) A jobber who holds a jobber license issued under this
- 23 chapter may offer fireworks for retail sale to the public only at a
- 24 location for which the jobber obtains a retail location permit from

- 1 the state fire marshal's office.
- 2 (b) A permit issued under this section expires on the date
- 3 the permit holder's jobber license expires under this chapter.
- 4 (c) A jobber who holds a retail location permit issued under
- 5 this section may offer fireworks for retail sale to the public at
- 6 the location specified in the permit during the period beginning
- 7 January 1 and ending at midnight on December 31.
- 8 SECTION 5. Sections 352.051(b) and (c), Local Government
- 9 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 10 (b)(1) The Texas  $\underline{A\&M}$  Forest Service in the ordinary course
- 11 of its activities shall determine whether drought conditions, as
- 12 defined under Subsection (a)(2), exist on average in any county
- 13 requesting such a determination. The Texas A&M Forest Service shall
- 14 make available the measurement index guidelines used to determine
- 15 whether drought conditions exist in a particular area. Following
- 16 any determination that such drought conditions exist, the Texas  $\underline{A\&M}$
- 17 Forest Service shall notify said county or counties when such
- 18 drought conditions no longer exist. The Texas  $\underline{A\&M}$  Forest Service
- 19 shall make its services available each <u>business</u> day [<del>during the</del>
- 20 Texas Independence Day, San Jacinto Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of
- 21 July, and December fireworks seasons] to respond to the request of
- 22 any county for a determination whether drought conditions exist on
- 23 average in the county.
- 24 (2) The Texas  $\underline{A\&M}$  Forest Service shall be allowed to
- 25 take such donations of equipment or funds as necessary to aid in the
- 26 carrying out of this section.
- 27 (c) Upon a determination under this section that drought

- 1 conditions exist on average in a specified county, the
- 2 commissioners court of the county by order may prohibit or restrict
- 3 the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated area
- 4 of the county. In addition, [during the December fireworks season,]
- 5 the commissioners court of a county by order may restrict or
- 6 prohibit the sale or use of restricted fireworks in specified areas
- 7 when conditions on rural acreage in the county not under
- 8 cultivation for a period of at least 12 months are determined to be
- 9 extremely hazardous for the danger of fire because of high grass or
- 10 dry vegetation.
- 11 SECTION 6. Section 352.051(d), Local Government Code, is
- 12 repealed.
- SECTION 7. Not later than December 1, 2019, the
- 14 commissioner of insurance shall adopt the rules and prescribe the
- 15 forms necessary to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
