4	SECTION 1. Section 2269.001, Government Code, is amended by
5	adding Subdivision (5-a) to read as follows:
6	(5-a) "Horizontal construction project" means:
7	(A) a highway, road, street, bridge, utility,
8	water supply project, water plant, wastewater plant, water and
9	wastewater distribution or conveyance facility, wharf, dock,
10	airport runway or taxiway, drainage project, or related type of
11	project associated with civil engineering construction; or
12	(B) work relating to a building or structure that
13	is incidental to a project that is primarily a civil engineering
14	construction project.
15	SECTION 2. Section 2269.004, Government Code, is amended to
16	read as follows:
17	Sec. 2269.004. <u>APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER TO CERTAIN</u>
18	TRANSPORTATION CONTRACTS, PROJECTS, AND ENTITIES [EXEMPTION: TEXAS
19	DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; HIGHWAY PROJECTS]. (a) Except as
20	otherwise provided by Subsections (b) and (c), this [This] chapter

Section 2269.401, Government Code, is amended to 22 read as follows: Sec. 2269.401. JOB ORDER CONTRACTING. In this chapter, 23 24 "job order contracting" is a procurement method used for maintenance, repair, alteration, renovation, remediation, or 25 26 [minor] construction of a facility or for a horizontal construction project when the [work is of a recurring nature but the delivery 27

2 SECTION 4. The heading to Section 2269.403, Government 3 Code, is amended to read as follows:

6 SECTION 5. Section 2269.403(a), Government Code, is amended 7 to read as follows:

8 (a) A governmental entity may award job order contracts for 9 the maintenance, repair, alteration, renovation, remediation, or 10 [minor] construction of a facility <u>or for a horizontal construction</u> 11 project if[+

12 [(1) the work is of a recurring nature but the delivery 13 times are indefinite; and

14 [(2)] indefinite quantities and orders are awarded
15 substantially on the basis of predescribed and prepriced tasks.

SECTION 6. Section 2269.404, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2269.404. CONTRACTUAL UNIT PRICES. The governmental entity <u>shall</u> [may] establish contractual unit prices for a job order contract by:

(1) specifying one or more published construction unit
 price books and the applicable divisions or line items; and [or]

(2) providing a list of work items and requiring the offerors to propose one or more coefficients or multipliers to be applied to the price book or prepriced work items as the price proposal.

27 SECTION 7. Section 2269.405(c), Government Code, is amended

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1 to read as follows:

(c) The governmental entity may require offerors to submit
information in addition to <u>the offeror's proposed coefficients or</u>
<u>multipliers</u> [rates], including experience, past performance, and
proposed personnel and methodology.

6 SECTION 8. Section 2269.406, Government Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 2269.406. AWARDING OF JOB ORDER CONTRACTS. The 9 governmental entity may award <u>a</u> job order <u>contract only</u> [contracts] 10 to one [or more] job order <u>contractor</u> [contractors] in connection 11 with each solicitation of proposals.

SECTION 9. Section 2269.408(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a job order contract or an order issued under the contract [for industrialized housing, industrialized buildings, or relocatable educational facilities subject to and approved under Chapter 1202, Occupations Code,] if the contractor employs the services of an architect or engineer who approves the documents for the project.

20 SECTION 10. Section 2269.410, Government Code, is amended 21 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 22 follows:

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(b) The order may be:

(1) a fixed price, lump-sum contract based
[substantially] on contractual unit pricing applied to <u>the scope of</u>
<u>work</u> [estimated quantities]; or

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(2) a unit price order based on the quantities and line

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1 items delivered.

2 (c) The order under a job order contract for a construction
3 project must include detailed line item descriptions, quantities,
4 and prices for each construction task, including the associated
5 coefficients or multipliers, to produce a lump-sum price of the
6 project.

7 SECTION 11. Sections 2269.006, 2269.007, 2269.008, 8 2269.009, 2269.010, and 2269.402, Government Code, are repealed.

9 SECTION 12. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a job order contract entered into or renewed on or after the 10 effective date of this Act and any order for a job or project under 11 that contract. A job order contract entered into or renewed before 12 the effective date of this Act and any order for a job or project 13 14 under that contract is governed by the law in effect immediately 15 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16

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SECTION 13. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
