- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 42.0537(a) and (b), Human Resources
- 7 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The department shall include a provision in each
- 9 contract with a child-placing agency with whom children in the
- 10 managing conservatorship of the department are placed that requires
- 11 the child-placing agency to provide [at least 35 hours of]
- 12 competency-based, preservice training to a potential caregiver
- 13 before the child-placing agency verifies or approves the caregiver
- 14 as a foster or adoptive home. The amount of training required by
- 15 this subsection may not exceed 35 hours.
- 16 (b) The department shall adopt policies to ensure that each
- 17 potential caregiver receives [at least 35 hours of]
- 18 competency-based, preservice training before the department
- 19 verifies or approves the caregiver as a foster or adoptive home.
- 20 The amount of training required by this subsection may not exceed 35
- 21 hours.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
