- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 86.0015, Election Code,

- 7 Sec. 86.0015. [ANNUAL] BALLOTS BY MAIL FOR MULTIPLE
- 8 ELECTIONS FOLLOWING SINGLE APPLICATION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 86.0015, Election Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 11 follows:

- 12 (b) An application described by Subsection (a) is
- 13 considered to be an application for a ballot for each election,
- 14 including any ensuing runoff:
- 15 (1) in which the applicant is eligible to vote; and
- 16 (2) that occurs before the earlier of:
- (A)  $\left[\frac{\text{except as provided by Subsection } (b-2)_{r}\right]$  the
- 18  $\,$  end of the  $\,$  next calendar year following the  $\,$  calendar year in which
- 19 the application was submitted;
- 20 (B) the date the county clerk receives notice
- 21 from the voter registrar under Subsection (f) that the voter has
- 22 changed residence to another county; or
- (C) the date the voter's registration is
- 24 canceled.

- (g) The county clerk shall provide to a voter who has 1 applied for and qualifies to receive ballots to be voted by mail 2 under this section, before the end of the last calendar year for 3 which the voter will receive ballots under this section, a notice 4 stating that the voter must make a new application under this 5
- 6 section if the voter wishes to continue to receive ballots to be
- 7 voted by mail.
- SECTION 3. Section 86.0015(b-2), Election 8 Code, is 9 repealed.
- SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act to Section 10
- 86.0015, Election Code, applies only to an application for a ballot 11
- to be voted by mail submitted on or after the effective date of this 12
- An application for a ballot to be voted by mail submitted 13
- before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 14
- 15 effect when the application was submitted, and the former law is
- continued in effect for that purpose. 16
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
