4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 32.024, Human Resources Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (ll) to read as follows:
7	(ll) In this subsection, "serious mental illness" has the
8	meaning assigned by Section 1355.001, Insurance Code. The
9	commission in its rules and standards governing the scope of
10	services provided under the medical assistance program shall
11	include behavioral health services for a person who:
12	(1) is at least 20 years of age but younger than 65
13	years of age;
14	(2) has been diagnosed with a serious mental illness;
15	and
16	(3) has been arrested at least once.
17	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
18	a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
19	federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
20	the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
21	authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
22	waiver or authorization is granted.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
