- 6 information disclosed under Sections 42.050(e) and 42.052(f-1)(5).
- 7 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 8 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 9 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement the
- 10 changes in law made by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 12 a license, certificate, or registration renewed on or after the
- 13 effective date of this Act. A license, certificate, or
- 14 registration renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 15 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective
- 16 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 17 purpose.
- 18 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
