1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to making a false statement or false representation in  
 1-20 certain documents filed with the Texas Alcoholic Beverage  
 1-21 Commission.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 101.69, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is  
 1-24 amended to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 101.69. FALSE STATEMENT. Except as provided in  
 1-26 Section 103.05(d), a person who knowingly makes a false statement  
 1-27 or false representation in an application for a permit or license or  
 1-28 in a statement, report, or other instrument to be filed with the  
 1-29 commission and required to be sworn commits an offense punishable  
 1-30 by imprisonment in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for not  
 1-31 less than 2 nor more than 10 years.

1-32 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
 1-33 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.  
 1-34 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is  
 1-35 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,  
 1-36 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For  
 1-37 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the  
 1-38 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred  
 1-39 before that date.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
