2	relating to a one-time supplemental annuity payment to certain
3	retirees and beneficiaries of the Teacher Retirement System of
4	Texas.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 824, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 824.010 to read as follows:

- 8 <u>Sec. 824.010. SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENT. (a) Notwithstanding</u> 9 Section 821.006, the retirement system may make a one-time
- 10 supplemental payment as provided by this section to an annuitant
- 11 eligible to receive a monthly retirement, disability, or death
- 12 benefit annuity under this subchapter. A supplemental payment made
- 13 <u>under this section:</u>
- 14 (1) is in addition to the regular monthly annuity
- 15 payment; and
- 16 (2) must be made using earnings the system makes on
- 17 <u>investments as provided by this section.</u>
- 18 (b) The retirement system shall pay the supplemental
- 19 payment in January following the fiscal year in which the actual
- 20 rate of return on the investment of the system's cash and securities
- 21 exceeds the assumed rate of return used in the actuarial valuation
- 22 prepared by the system for that fiscal year.
- 23 <u>(c) The retirement system shall determine the aggregate</u>
 24 supplemental payment amount available for making supplemental

- 1 payments under this section by:
- 2 (1) requiring the system's actuary to determine the
- 3 value of the system's investment returns that represent the amount
- 4 by which the actual rate of return exceeds the assumed rate of
- 5 return under Subsection (d); and
- 6 (2) multiplying that value by 50 percent.
- 7 (d) The board of trustees shall, based on the aggregate
- 8 supplemental payment amount, determine:
- 9 (1) who is eligible to receive the supplemental
- 10 payment based on years of service, effective date of retirement or
- 11 death, as applicable, and other reasonable criteria;
- 12 (2) the amount of each annuitant's supplemental
- 13 payment; and
- 14 (3) the manner in which the payment is made.
- (e) This section expires on the second anniversary of the
- 16 date on which the supplemental payment authorized under this
- 17 section is made.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
