4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2051, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter E to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER E. NOTICE BY PUBLICATION IN MEDIA OTHER THAN NEWSPAPER
8	Sec. 2051.151. NOTICE BY PUBLICATION ON INTERNET. (a) In
9	addition to any law requiring notice be published by newspaper and
10	subject to Subsection (b), a political subdivision shall provide
11	notice:
12	(1) on an Internet website maintained by the
13	comptroller; and
14	(2) on the political subdivision's Internet website.
15	(b) A political subdivision may request from the
16	comptroller and the comptroller may grant a waiver from the
17	requirements of Subsection (a) if the political subdivision
18	provides sufficient proof that Internet access is limited in the
19	political subdivision. If the comptroller grants the waiver, the
20	political subdivision must provide additional notice on a public
21	agenda board within the political subdivision.
22	(c) Notice published under this section must be made
23	available for the period required by law for which the publication
24	of the notice is required in a newspaper.

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1	Sec. 2051.152. NOTICE BY ALTERNATIVE MEDIA. (a) A
2	political subdivision may satisfy a requirement in any other law to
3	provide notice by publication in a newspaper by publishing the
4	notice by media described by Subsection (b) that the political
5	subdivision determines has greater circulation than the newspaper
6	with the greatest circulation in the political subdivision.
7	(b) The following forms of media are authorized for
8	providing notice under Subsection (a):
9	(1) social media;
10	(2) free newspapers;
11	<pre>(3) school newspapers;</pre>
12	(4) a homeowners' association newsletter or magazine;
13	(5) utility bills;
14	(6) direct mailings; and
15	(7) any other form of media authorized by the
16	<u>comptroller.</u>
17	(c) A political subdivision that provides notice using
18	alternative media under this section shall submit notice to the
19	comptroller describing the alternative notice method that
20	<u>includes:</u>
21	(1) the number of subscribers within the political
22	subdivision of the newspaper with the greatest circulation in the
23	political subdivision;
24	(2) a description of the alternative media used for
25	the notice; and
26	(3) the circulation of the alternative media used for
27	the notice.

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1	Sec. 2051.153. COMPTROLLER ALTERNATIVE NOTICE REPORT. (a)
2	The comptroller shall prepare a report that identifies and compares
3	the effectiveness of different methods of notice publication used
4	by political subdivisions. The report must include all types of
5	notice that are used under this chapter and laws that require the
6	publication of a notice in a newspaper.
7	(b) Not later than December 31 of each even-numbered year,
8	the comptroller shall submit the report described by Subsection (a)
9	to the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of
10	representatives.
11	(c) This section expires January 1, 2023.
12	Sec. 2051.154. RULEMAKING AUTHORITY. The comptroller may
13	adopt rules necessary to administer this chapter.
14	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
