- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 547.405(d), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer that is equipped
- 8 with air or vacuum brakes or that has a gross weight heavier than
- 9 4,500 [3,000] pounds shall be equipped with brakes that:
- 10 (1) operate on all wheels required to have brakes
- 11 under Section 547.402; and
- 12 (2) are promptly applied automatically and remain
- 13 applied for at least 15 minutes in case of a breakaway from the
- 14 towing vehicle.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 22 before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
