## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to a grant program for school districts to provide career
- 3 and technology education courses in the summer and to a study on the
- 4 grant program.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Sections 29.194 and 29.1941 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 29.194. SUMMER CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION GRANT
- 9 PROGRAM. (a) From funds appropriated or available for the purpose,
- 10 the commissioner, in cooperation with an appropriate private
- 11 entity, shall establish a grant program to provide funding to
- 12 school districts for career and technology education courses
- 13 <u>offered during the summer.</u>
- 14 (b) The commissioner may solicit and accept gifts,
- 15 donations, or other contributions for the grant program established
- 16 under this section.
- 17 <u>(c) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 18 <u>implement this section</u>.
- 19 Sec. 29.1941. STUDY ON SUMMER CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY
- 20 EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM. (a) From funds appropriated or available
- 21 for the purpose, the commissioner, in cooperation with an
- 22 appropriate private entity, shall conduct a study regarding the
- 23 summer career and technology education grant program established
- 24 under Section 29.194. The study must analyze:

- 1 (1) the success of the grant program;
- 2 (2) the feasibility of expanding the grant program,
- 3 including by funding career and technology education courses
- 4 offered during the summer through the Foundation School Program;
- 5 (3) the potential demand for career and technology
- 6 education courses during the summer;
- 7 (4) any future funding needs for the grant program or
- 8 for providing career and technology education courses during the
- 9 summer; and
- 10 (5) any other matter the commissioner determines
- 11 appropriate.
- 12 (b) Not later than December 1, 2020, the commissioner shall
- 13 submit to the governor and the members of the legislature a report
- 14 on the results of the study and any recommendations for legislative
- 15 or other action.
- 16 <u>(c) The commissioner may solicit and accept gifts,</u>
- 17 donations, or other contributions for the study and report under
- 18 this section.
- 19 (d) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- SECTION 2. Section 29.194, Education Code, as added by this
- 21 Act, applies beginning with the 2019-2020 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
