1 committed] against a pregnant individual to force the individual to 2 have an abortion.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 3 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 5 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 7 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 8 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 9 before that date. 10
