A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

requirements for and limitations relating to certain design-build contracts for highway projects of the Texas Department of Transportation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 223.242(d-1), Transportation Code, amended to read as follows:

(d-1) The department may not enter into more than six [three] contracts under this section in each state fiscal biennium [year].

SECTION 2. Section 223.246(a), Transportation Code, amended to read as follows:

- (a) The department shall issue a request for proposals to proposers short-listed under Section 223.245. A request for proposals must include:
 - information on the overall project goals; (1)
- (2) publicly available cost estimates for design-build portion of the project;
 - (3) materials specifications;
 - (4)special material requirements;
- a [schematic] design approximately 30 percent (5)complete;
- (6) known utilities, provided that the department is not required to undertake an effort to locate utilities;
- (7) assurance quality and requirements;
 - (8) the location of relevant structures;
- (9) notice of any rules or goals adopted by the department relating to awarding contracts to disadvantaged business enterprises or small business enterprises;
- (10) available geotechnical or other information related to the project;
- (11)the status of any environmental review of the project;
- (12)detailed instructions preparing technical proposal required under Subsection (d), including a description of the form and level of completeness of drawings expected;
- (13) the relative weighting of the technical and cost proposals required under Subsection (d) and the formula by which 1-56 1-57 1-58 the proposals will be evaluated and ranked; and
- 1-59 (14) the criteria to be used in evaluating the technical proposals, and the relative weighting of those criteria. 1-60 1-61 SECTION 3. Section 223.246(a), Transportation Code, as

amended by this Act, applies only to a highway project for which a request for qualifications is issued on or after the effective date 2-1 2-2 of this Act. A highway project for which a request for qualifications is issued before the effective date of this Act is 2-3 2-4 2**-**5 2**-**6 governed by the law in effect on the date the request for qualifications was issued, and that law is continued in effect for 2-7 that purpose. 2-8

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
