Section 21.016(d), Property Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (d) Notice may be served [+ [(1)] by delivering a copy of the notice to the party 8 9 or to the party's agent or attorney or in another manner provided by the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure for service of citation [+ 10 [(2) if the property being condemned belongs to a 11 12 deceased's estate or to a minor or other legally disabled person and 13 the person or estate has a legal representative, by delivering a copy of the notice to the legal representative; or 14 15 [(3) if the property being condemned belongs to a 16 nonresident of this state and there has been no personal service on 17 the owner, if the identity or the residence of the property owner is unknown, or if the property owner avoids service of notice by 18 hiding, by publication in the same manner as service of citation by 19 publication in other civil cases in the district courts or county 20 21 courts at law]. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24

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Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
