- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 502.407, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that
- 8 at the time of the offense:
- 9 <u>(1) the office of the county assessor-collector for</u>
- 10 the county in which the owner of the vehicle resided was closed for
- 11 a protracted period of time in accordance with Section
- 12 <u>502.040(b)(2);</u> and
- 13 (2) the vehicle's registration was expired for 30
- 14 working days or less.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 19 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 22 before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
