5 SECTION 1. Section 1603.252(a), Occupations Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) The department may accept, <u>approve</u>, develop, or

12 Sec. 1603.255. EARLY EXAMINATION. The department may 13 allow for the early written examination of a student who has 14 completed the following number of hours of instruction in a 15 department-approved training program:

16 (1) 1,000 hours for a student seeking a Class A barber 17 certificate [or operator license] in a private barber [or 18 cosmetology] school; [or]

19 (2) 900 hours for a student seeking a Class A barber 20 certificate [or operator license] in a publicly funded barber [or 21 cosmetology] school; or

22 (3) 1,000 hours, including 150 hours in sanitation and 23 safety, for a student seeking an operator license in a private 24 beauty culture school or a public secondary or postsecondary beauty

2 SECTION 3. Section 1603.256(c), Occupations Code, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 (c) The following persons may administer a practical5 examination required under this subchapter:

(1) the department; [<del>or</del>]

8 Section 1603.252;

9 (3) a barber school, private beauty culture school, or 10 public secondary or postsecondary beauty culture school that is 11 approved by the department to administer the examination under 12 Section 1603.252; or

SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Section 15 1603.255, Occupations Code, apply only to a person who applies to 16 take an early examination for a barbering or cosmetology license on 17 or after the effective date of this Act. A person who applies to 18 take an early examination before the effective date of this Act is 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the person applies, and 20 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
