- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 1, Chapter 1291, Acts of the 76th
- 5 Legislature, Regular Session, 1999, is amended by adding Section
- 6 1.07 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1.07. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 8 article, not later than January 1, 2020, the City of Houston shall
- 9 enter into a contractual agreement with the Brazos River Authority
- 10 to transfer to the Brazos River Authority that city's ownership
- 11 interests in the Allens Creek Reservoir project, including all
- 12 required water right permits, along with the responsibility to
- 13 construct the project in accordance with all associated statutory
- 14 requirements and deadlines.
- 15 (b) Construction of the reservoir is subject to the Brazos
- 16 River Authority obtaining all necessary federal permits.
- 17 <u>(c) In addition to other necessary provisions, the</u>
- 18 contractual agreement described by Subsection (a) must include
- 19 provisions for:
- 20 (1) the transfer of an amount not to exceed \$5 million
- 21 from the Brazos River Authority to the City of Houston; and
- 22 (2) an option, available for a period of one year from

- 1 Brazos River Authority at the Brazos River Authority's then current
- 2 system rate for raw water.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
