- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter L, Chapter 2054,
- 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER L. STATEWIDE TECHNOLOGY CENTERS AND CLOUD COMPUTING
- 8 SERVICES
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2054.375, Government Code, is amended by
- 10 10 amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (1-a) to read as
- 11 follows:

- 12 (1) "Cloud computing service" has the meaning assigned
- 13 by Section 2157.007.
- 14 (1-a) "Governmental entity" means a state agency or
- 15 local government.
- SECTION 3. Section 2054.378, Government Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 2054.378. AUTHORIZATION FOR CLOUD COMPUTING SERVICES
- 19 OR SELECTION FOR CENTER SERVICES; SCOPE OF OPERATION OF CENTERS.
- 20 (a) The department shall:
- 21 (1) allows a state agency to contract with a cloud
- 22 computing service provider for services described by Subsection
- 23 (b); or
- 24 (2) allows a state agency to utilize services

- 1 described by subsection (b) by a statewide technology center.
- 2 (b) The department may operate statewide technology centers
- 3 to provide two or more governmental entities, on a cost-sharing
- 4 basis, services relating to:
- 5 (1) information resources and information resources
- 6 technology; and
- 7 (2) the deployment, development, and maintenance of
- 8 software applications.
- 9 (c) [<del>(b)</del>] The department may operate a statewide technology
- 10 10 center directly or contract with another person to operate the 11
- 11 center.
- 12 (d) agencies have a choice in determining whether to utilize
- 13 a cloud service provider and/or the statewide technology center.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 2054.382(a), Government Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 (a) <u>Either a cloud service provider</u> or the department <u>may</u>
- 17 [shall] manage the operations of 15 statewide technology centers
- 18 that provide data center services or disaster recovery services for
- 19 two or more state agencies, including management of the operations
- 20 of the center on the campus of Angelo State University.
- 21 SECTION 5. Section 2054.384, Government Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- Sec. 2054.384. COST AND REQUIREMENTS ANALYSIS. (a) <u>Each</u>
- 24 state agency the department considers for participation under this
- 25 subchapter [The department] shall conduct a cost and requirements
- 26 analysis to determine the agency's information resource technology
- 27 needs and shall consider using a cloud computing service, including

- 1 any security benefits and cost savings associated with purchasing
- 2 the service from a cloud computing service provider, or [for each
- 3 state agency that the department intends to select for
- 4 participation in ] a statewide technology center.
- 5 (b) A [selected] state agency shall identify the agency's
- 6 [its] particular technology requirements, operations costs, and
- 7 requested service levels for the department. The department may 6
- 8 require a state agency to validate or resubmit data related to these
- 9 factors. [The department shall fulfill the requirements and
- 10 service levels of each state agency to the extent possible.
- 11 SECTION 6. Section 2054.390, Government Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 2054.390. PRIORITIZATION AND USE OF EXISTING CAPACITY
- 14 REQUIRED [MIGRATION OF SERVICES]. If the [(a) The] department
- 15 <u>adopts a</u> [shall prioritize the migration of services to the
- 16 statewide technology center system established under this
- 17 subchapter based on the size of the current technology center
- 18 operational environment at a state agency, with the largest 25
- 19 technology center environments ranking highest in priority.
- 20 [(c) A state agency shall comply with the department's
- 21 request to migrate under this section.
- 22 [<del>(d) Any</del>] consolidation plan <u>to migrate services to a</u>
- 23 statewide technology center established under this subchapter, the
- 24 <u>department shall</u> [adopted by the department to execute this section
- 25 must] prioritize and fully use the existing capacity of the State
- 26 Data Center located on the campus of Angelo State University.
- 27 SECTION 7. Section 2054.392, Government Code, is amended to

- 1 read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 2054.392. STATEWIDE TECHNOLOGY ACCOUNT. The
- 3 comptroller shall establish in the state treasury the statewide
- 4 technology account. The account is a revolving fund account for the
- 5 administration of this subchapter. The account is the depository
- 6 for all money received from entities served under this subchapter.
- 7 Money in the account may be used only for  $\underline{a}$  [the operation and
- 8 management of a statewide technology center or for any other]
- 9 purpose specified by the legislature.
- 10 SECTION 8. Sections 2054.382(c) and (d) and Section
- 11 2054.391, Government Code, are repealed.
- 12 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
