## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 521.165, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (e) The department may authorize and set standards for an
- 10 entity described by Subsection (a), including a driver education
- 11 school described by Section 521.1655, to administer, and train and
- 12 certify examiners to administer, the examination required by
- 13 Section 521.161(b)(2).
- 14 (f) An entity described by Subsection (a) may not issue a
- 15 temporary receipt under Section 521.1812 to a person who has not
- 16 completed and passed the training and testing conducted by the
- 17 entity under this section.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter I, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 19 is amended by adding Section 521.1812 to read as follows:
- Sec. 521.1812. ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY RECEIPT BY THIRD
- 21 PARTY. (a) The department may authorize an entity described by
- 22 Section 521.165, including a driver education school described by
- 23 Section 521.1655, to issue a temporary receipt to a qualifying
- 24 applicant who has met all requirements for a driver's license if the

- 1 qualifying applicant holds a learner license issued by the
- 2 department under Section 521.222.
- 3 (b) A temporary receipt issued under Subsection (a) serves
- 4 <u>as temporary permission to operate a vehicle until the department</u>
- 5 provides a driver's license to the qualifying applicant.
- 6 (c) The department shall develop a process for an entity
- 7 under Subsection (a) to electronically transmit to the department
- 8 the documents and information required by the department for the
- 9 issuance of a driver's license to a qualifying applicant.
- 10 (d) The department shall adopt rules to implement this
- 11 section.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
