A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the issuance of a driver's license by an entity other 3 than the Department of Public Safety.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 521.165, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to read as 7 follows:

8 (a) The director may certify and set standards for the 9 certification of certain employers, government agencies, and other 10 appropriate organizations to allow those persons to train and test 11 for the ability to operate <u>the</u> [certain] types of vehicles <u>a holder</u> 12 <u>of a Class C driver's license is authorized to operate</u>.

13 (f) An entity described by Subsection (a) may not issue a 14 driver's license under Section 521.181 to a person who has not 15 completed and passed the training and testing conducted by the 16 entity under this section.

SECTION 2. Section 521.181, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

19 Sec. 521.181. ISSUANCE OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. (a) On payment 20 of the required fee, the department shall issue to each qualifying 21 applicant a driver's license of the class for which the applicant 22 has applied.

(b) The department may authorize an entity described by
Section 521.165 to issue a driver's license to a qualifying

- 1 applicant if the qualifying applicant holds a learner license
- 2 issued by the department under Section 521.222. The department
- 3 shall adopt rules to implement this subsection.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
