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- 2 relating to the assessment of public school students in writing
- 3 under an alternative method.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-14) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(a-14)</u> An assessment instrument administered to students in
- 8 grade four to assess skills in writing is not subject to Subsections
- 9 (a-12) and (a-13).
- 10 SECTION 2. Sections 39.02301(b), (f), (h), and (j),
- 11 Education Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 12 (b) During the 2020-2021 [2016-2017] and 2021-2022
- 13 [2017-2018] school years, the agency shall operate [establish] a
- 14 pilot program as provided by this section to implement in
- 15 designated school districts the writing assessment method
- 16 developed under Subsection (a).
- 17 (f) The agency, in consultation with teachers, shall
- 18 develop a rubric for scoring student writing assessments under the
- 19 pilot program. The individuals responsible for scoring student
- 20 writing assessments [under the pilot program] shall be coordinated
- 21 [jointly] by the agency with joint participation of:
- 22 (1) the school district in which the student is
- 23 enrolled and that is participating in the pilot program;
- 24 (2) a public junior college or institution of higher

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- 1 education that enters into an agreement with the participating
- 2 school district; and
- 3 (3) the regional education service center that serves
- 4 the participating district.
- 5 (h) [Not later than September 1, 2016, the agency shall
- 6 prepare and deliver to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the
- 7 speaker of the house of representatives, and the presiding officer
- 8 of each legislative standing committee with primary jurisdiction
- 9 over primary and secondary education a report covering the study of
- 10 the development of the writing assessment method under Subsection
- 11 (a). Not later than September 1, 2021, and September 1, 2022 [of
- 12 each year in 2017 and 2018], the agency shall prepare and deliver to
- 13 the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
- 14 representatives, and the presiding officer of each legislative
- 15 standing committee with primary jurisdiction over primary and
- 16 secondary education a report that:
- 17 (1) evaluates the implementation and progress of the
- 18 pilot program under this section; and
- 19 (2) makes recommendations regarding the continuation
- 20 or expansion of the pilot program.
- 21 (j) This section expires September 1, 2023 [2019].
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
