- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.02(b), Penal Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (b) An offense under this section is a felony of the second
- 8 degree, except that the offense is a felony of the first degree if:
- 9 (1) the actor uses a deadly weapon during the

commission of the assault and causes serious bodily injury to

- 11 another, including the person's spouse [a person whose relationship
- 12 to or association with the defendant is described by Section
- 13 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005, Family Code];
- 14 (2) regardless of whether the offense is committed
- 15 under Subsection (a)(1) or (a)(2), the offense is committed:
- 16 (A) by a public servant acting under color of the
- 17 servant's office or employment;
- 18 (B) against a person the actor knows is a public
- 19 servant while the public servant is lawfully discharging an
- 20 official duty, or in retaliation or on account of an exercise of
- 21 official power or performance of an official duty as a public
- 22 servant;
- (C) in retaliation against or on account of the
- 24 service of another as a witness, prospective witness, informant, or

- 1 person who has reported the occurrence of a crime; or
- 2 (D) against a person the actor knows is a
- 3 security officer while the officer is performing a duty as a
- 4 security officer; or
- 5 (3) the actor is in a motor vehicle, as defined by
- 6 Section 501.002, Transportation Code, and:
- 7 (A) knowingly discharges a firearm at or in the
- 8 direction of a habitation, building, or vehicle;
- 9 (B) is reckless as to whether the habitation,
- 10 building, or vehicle is occupied; and
- 11 (C) in discharging the firearm, causes serious
- 12 bodily injury to any person.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 18 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 19 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 20 before that date.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
